 - primary course of action planning option is to conduct local flying and Aerospace Control Alert from Columbia Metropolitan Airport

Operations and Training

- Ongoing Continued support of State COVID response critical staffing needs and support across the state; vaccine distribution and administering
- 28 May-26 June Joint Exercise with Australia, Pacific Sentry/Talisman Saber '21 Exercise (Joint Air Component Coordination Element) –
- 6-25 June in Missouri MDG Exercise Operation Healthy Delta
 - Theme helping people, changing lives
 - Total Patients seen + 2k
 - Precedures completed + 11k
 - Prescriptions filled +1500
 - Glasses provided +700
 - Community Value +1M
- Also in June Hosting ANG Civil Engineering unit from The US Virgin Islands (St Croix) for a Deployment for Training
 - Accomplished Base improvement projects as well as training and readiness;
- At the end of July we concluded out '21 SWA Deployment PSAB
 - $\circ \sim 300+$ recently returned and preparing to return to work
- 31 Aug 1 Sept,, McEntire JNGB is hosting USINDOPACOM-sponsored Joint Capabilities Technology Demonstration
 - selected from over 200 military installations world-wide, this demonstration will focus on developing a conops for Airfield Damage Repair across the Joint Force; in an effort to develop new concept of operations for the Joint Force –

Community

- COVID prevention have reduced the overall amount of tours and meetings hosted on the installation.
- COVID impacts on Community Outreach
 - Annual Top Gun Drill canceled for March (approx. 1,000 participants and fans)
 - McEntire STEM Day canceled for April (hundreds of local school kids)
 - McEntire Family Day canceled for April
 - National Guard Association of SC annual conference cancelled this year
- We are still doing targeted engagement with appropriate COVID prevention protocols.
 - Congresswoman Mace visited McEntire 18 Aug
 - Planning to host new State Reps and new County Council members when appropriate
- STARBASE Swamp Fox Summer Camp was held 27-30 July

- Hosted NGB Head of the Contracting Activity and Senior Contracting Official 1 Jul
- Mission Sustainment/Encroachment Management
 - Richland County Land Development Code rewrite;
 - Base feedback has been submitted, prepared to review any final drafts
 - Kudos to the County Planning team for their assistance
- ANG Federal Tuition Assistance Beta Program
 - Drill Status Guardsmen (enlisted & officer) can now take advantage of Federal TA to pursue off-duty educational opportunities
 - 100% tuition NTE \$250/sem credit hr, \$166/qtr credit hr, \$4,500 max/yr
 - Up to 124 sem hours for undergraduate degree; 42 sem hr graduate degree
 - National/Regional Accredited institution, recognized by DoE, signed DOD Partnership memo
